Q2 FEATURED PROJECTS



MYERS POINT (THE OVERLOOK) PERRY HILL DEVELOPMENT, LLC

We completed site development for Perry Hill Development, LLC in conjunction with DR Horton, transforming a 14.50-acre tract into an 86-lot townhome community in the Town of Moncks Corner. The project included construction of a new SCDOT access road with turn lane, a sanitary sewer pump station, approximately 3,443 LF of force main, gravity sewer, water distribution, and a comprehensive storm drainage system consisting of 2,962 LF of pipe and 39 drainage structures. Additional work included installation of 4,690 LF of curb, excavation of six on-site stormwater ponds, construction of approximately 2,200 LF of internal roadways, and placement of approximately 1,600 tons of asphalt, delivering complete infrastructure to support the new residential development.

TANGER OUTLET SHOPPING CENTER TANGER MANAGEMENT

This quarter, our Asphalt Department completed the milling and repaving of the Tanger Outlets parking lot in North Charleston for Tanger Management. By removing the worn surface and replacing it with new asphalt, our crews restored the parking lot to withstand the heavy traffic throughout the area. From careful planning to final paving, our crews worked efficiently to deliver a finished project that minimized disruptions for shoppers and businesses.



CAMP HALL INDUSTRIAL PARK CHANDLER CONSTRUCTION SERVICES

Our Vac Cam Department is continuing to support Chandler Construction Services with hydro-excavation, safe dig, and utility support services at the Camp Hall Industrial Park Expansion. This aligns with the new SC811 legislation that took effect at the end of May requiring daylighting (non-mechanical excavation) for any known utilities prior to digging. Our Vac Cam department continues to provide safe dig solutions to many local construction companies, as well as expanding and improving services in pipe cleaning and CCTV inspections. This includes the addition of a 3rd pipe inspection truck completing our upgrade to HD video technology and real time cloud access for customers.
